The deadline for the Export GA internship is being extended to November 5<sup>th</sup>. The applications (which require a resume) are going to be outside of room 265A on the bulletin board. Please get your application in if you want to participate in this exciting program. To review, you will provide market research and analysis support to a select few companies to help them develop and implement an international business plan. You will be assigned directly to a company to attend one day of export training per month and help complete the company’s assignments. Students will receive 3 credit hours for a major class, INTB 4800. This internship is paid \$6.00 an hour for up to 65 hours. They are accepting 10 International Business students for Spring quarter. Yes, you can do this and take classes!
