Peking University (Beijing, China)

This exchange program with the Guanghua School of Management at Peking University allows *undergraduates and graduate students* to study business and language courses (taught in English) for one semester. Guanghua is consistently ranked as one of the top business schools in China.

Students can choose to apply for Fall or Spring enrollment.

Submit application and required documents to International Business Programs in 356/357 Brooks Hall.

**Fall: February 1
Spring: September 15**

ESTIMATED COSTS

Application Fee:

Approx. \$60/PKU (\$0/UGA)

Program Fee:

Students will pay in-state tuition & fees. OIE will send details upon acceptance.

Varies

Transfer Credit Approval Form:

If selected, the Office of International Education (OIE) requires a fee to ensure credit will be approved as well as to keep the Financial Aid Office informed of your status in the program.

International Airfare:

Students will be responsible for their own roundtrip airfare. Check on-line or with a local travel agent.

Accommodation:

Peking U. provides accommodation alternatives and will assist students in securing appropriate housing upon acceptance into the program.

Meals:

Students will be responsible for their own meals. Price approximation based on University cafeteria estimates.

Misc.: Students should also budget money for local transportation, laundry, books, internet/phone calls, excursions, souvenirs, etc.
