Maymester In Tanzania 2008 Study Abroad Program Payment and Refund Schedule

Fees to be paid to the Bursar's Office

Tuition and fees should be paid directly to the UGA Bursar's Office after course registration according to regular UGA payment schedule. Payment instructions will be given when you register in OASIS.

- Tuition: app. \$1,167/6 credit hours (NOTE: You must register for 6 credit hours).
- Technology Fee: app. \$25
- For non-University System of Georgia, out-of-state residents: \$125 out-of-state fee

Fees to be paid to the Program - \$5700

Make checks payable to: UGA, Maymester in Tanzania

- Application and \$200 application fee due by January 21.
- First installment of \$2500 due by February 18.
- Kilimanjaro Climbers only, installment of \$1090 due by: March 3.
- Second and final installment of \$3000 due by: April 4.

Deferred payment of program fees:

You must provide ILA with a copy of the award letter for any loans, grants, scholarships that you will use to cover any portion of the program fee in order to defer this payment until funds are received. This must be done prior to the deadline stated for payments. You will be required to pay any portion of the program fee not covered by financial aid at the stated deadlines. You may not defer payment of application fee!

Refund Schedule

- If the program is full at the time a student applies, or the student is not accepted into the program, the \$200 application fee will be refunded.
- If a student withdraws from program on or before April 30, then student will receive a refund of all fees minus \$200 application fee and all fees already paid by program on behalf of student.
- For any withdrawal from the program after April 30, no refund will be made to student of any fees paid.

Program Cancellation

- If the program is cancelled due to insufficient student enrollment, then a full refund of monies paid will be given to each student.
- If the program is cancelled due to an act of war or terrorism, a State Department warning or other circumstances that make the program location unsafe, all monies not already spent on behalf of the student will be refunded to each student.

Requests for Refunds

All requests for refunds must be made **in writing** to the Institute for Leadership Advancement, and received in the ILA office (367 Brooks Hall, UGA, Athens, GA 30602) by deadlines noted above.
