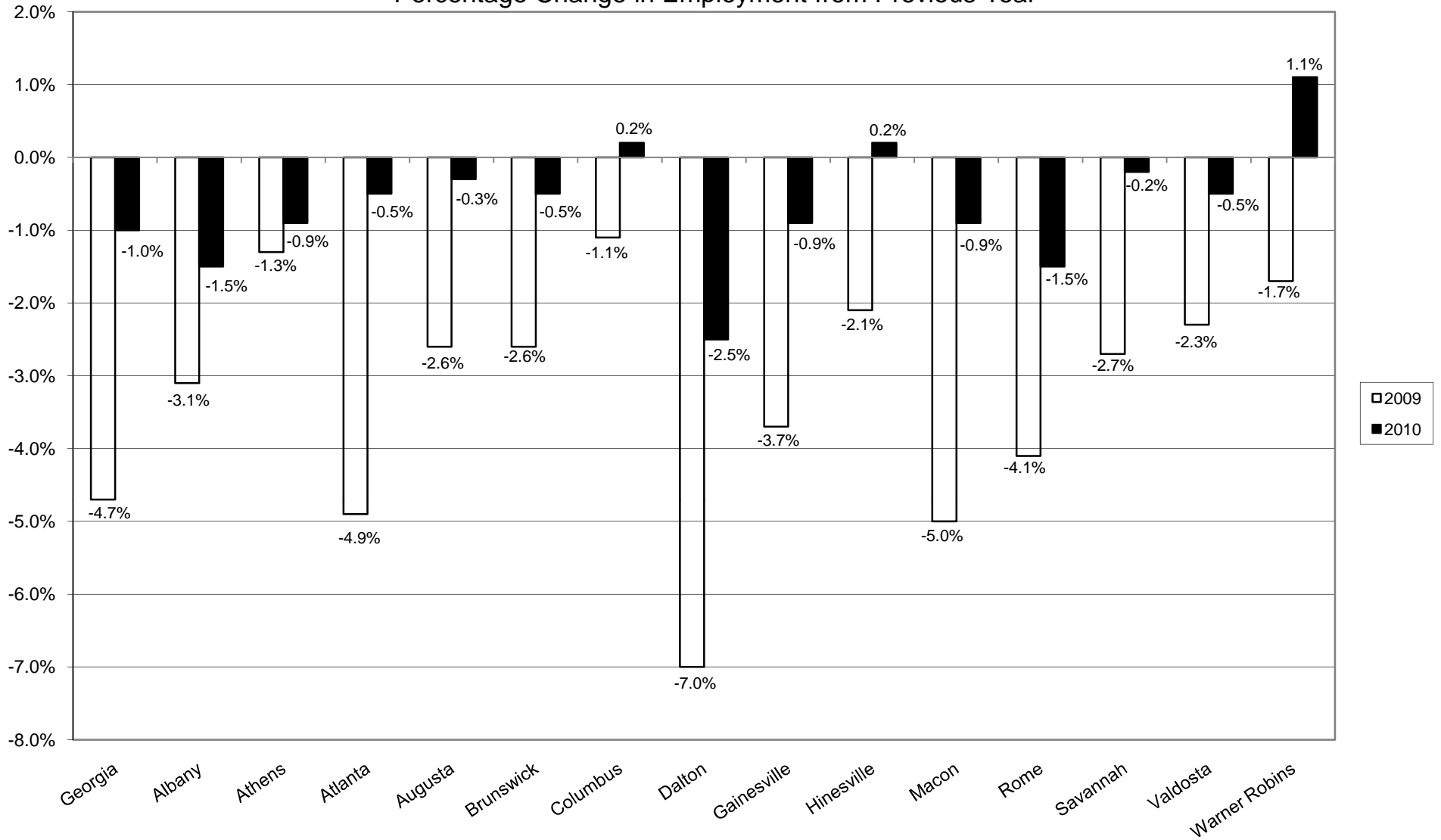


## Georgia's Employment Forecast for Metropolitan Areas
