RE: New Courses for Students on Assistantships

With the help of the University Curriculum Committee, the Graduate School is establishing two courses effective Spring 2003 that will provide your graduate students who are on a 0.33-time assistantship or higher to enroll for 3 hours of credit each semester. [If a student is not on funding at this level, they are not eligible for enrolling in the course.]

The courses are: 7005 Graduate Assistant Seminar and 9005 Doctoral Graduate Assistant Seminar.

These courses will have your departmental prefix and will be offered every semester (fall, spring, summer).

The courses may not be used on a student's program of study.

If you have already begun to create a departmental course to meet this need, you should stop that process and use our course so that it is a standard number across campus just as the research hours are now (7000/9000).
