Arts and Sciences Electives: 1000-level or above courses taught through the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences.

General Electives: Four (3-hour) courses required. Choose from 4000-level or above business courses outside the major and/or 3000-level or above courses outside Terry. MIST 4700, MIS Internship, may be used for three hours of General Elective credit. Two MIST courses (maximum 6 hours) may be used with permission of the major advisor.

The Honors equivalent of any course may be used in the four-year program.

Course options are planned in conjunction with your academic advisor.
