I design courses that balance conceptual rigor with hands-on application, emphasizing structured problem-solving, spreadsheet-based modeling, and real-world decision making. Across courses such as Basic and Applied Corporate Finance (FINA 4200; 4210), Financial Institutions and Markets (FINA 4000), and advanced offerings such as Financial Modeling (FINA 4920E), I use a scaffolded approach that integrates lectures, guided practice, case studies, in-class projects, group work, and experiential learning. ABOUT MY RESEARCH INTERESTS

My research training is in empirical corporate finance, with a focus on corporate governance, share-holder activism, and investor skill. My doctoral research examined heterogeneity in activist investor performance, using large-sample empirical methods, event-study frameworks, and Bayesian estimation techniques. My primary completed project studies hedge fund activism skill, documenting persistent differences in value creation across activists and their implications for takeover outcomes, long-term firm performance, and shareholder wealth. Related work examines the timing of hedge fund activism waves across industries, while additional collaborative research extends these ideas to retail investor skill in social trading environments. Since completing my PhD, my research engagement has become more selective and collaborative, with a focus on contributing to and completing existing projects; and supporting ongoing engagement with academic finance literature in ways that complement my primary role as a finance educator.
