GETTING THERE

The hotel is 5 miles from Ronald Reagan International Airport (DCA).

Using the <u>Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (METRO)</u>, take the YELLOW LINE towards MOUNT VERNON SQUARE to GALLERY PLACE CHINATOWN, exit at GALLERY PLACE CHINATOWN station via Entrance C (7th Street & H Street), walk 0.2 miles to 999 9th Street, NW

Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) is 27.8 miles from the hotel.

METRO service from Dulles, take the SILVER LINE towards LARGO to METRO CENTER, at METRO CENTER transfer to the RED LINE towards GLENMONT to GALLERY PLACE CHINATOWN, exit at GALLERY PLACE CHINATOWN station via Entrance C (7th Street & H Street), walk 0.2 miles to 999 9th Street, NW

Baltimore/Washington International (BWI) Thurgood Marshall Airport, 27.8 miles from hotel.

From BWI the MARC Train service is available. Take the shuttle bus from BWI to BWI MARC/Amtrak Station, take MARC Train Southbound towards Washington to WASHINGTON UNION STATION, walk approximately 1.2 miles (~25 min) to 999 9th Street, NW

Amtrak and other train services are available at UNION Station (1.2 miles).

Airport shuttle service is not available, but the METRO and Uber/Lyft/Taxis are easily accessed.
