Step 2: To be eligible to proceed from your BBA program directly into the MAcc program, you will use your Terry Electives (12 hours) or other electives to complete the following four ACCT courses:

ACCT 5000 (Intermediate I)

ACCT 5010 (Intermediate II)

ACCT 5400 (Tax I)

ACCT 5310 (Accounting Information Systems and Data Analytics)

If you do not have sufficient elective hours to complete these four courses for credit towards your BBA, then you must complete the hours in addition to the requirements of your BBA.

Step 3: Upon completion of these four courses you would be eligible to apply for the MAcc degree with a focus in Advisory. You will be required to complete the following courses to receive your MAcc degree:

ACCT 7200 (Audit I)

ACCT 7020 (Intermediate III)

ACCT 7410 (Tax II)

ACCT 7605 (Advanced Accounting)

Accounting Electives (6 Hours):

ACCT 7620 (Audit II)

ACCT 7630 (Accounting Data, Risk & Control)

ACCT 7700 (Accounting Policy & Research)

ACCT 7600 (FSA)

ACCT 7650 (IFRS)

ACCT 7651 (Forensic)

ACCT 7800 (Internship)

Advisory/Consulting Electives (12 Hours):

Will be structured to allow students to choose an Advisory area of interest (e.g. Finance, MIS, Business Analytics, etc.)

NOTE: You will have sufficient credit hours upon completion of the BBA/MAcc to sit for the CPA exam.
