RESIDENCIES

OPENING RESIDENCY (ATHENS)

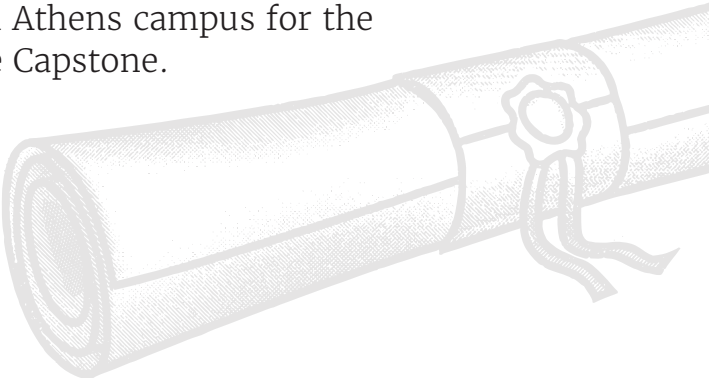
The opening residency for the Executive MBA Program is held at the University of Georgia Athens Campus. The residency is held Monday through Thursday in September of the first year, and student accommodations are provided.

INTERNATIONAL RESIDENCY

The international residency immerses you in a global business environment through 7–9 days of rewarding learning experiences. The destination is typically announced 6 months ahead of travel, and the costs associated with the residency are covered excluding some meals, personal incidentals, and round-trip airfare/visa costs.

CLOSING RESIDENCY (ATHENS)

Students return to the University of Georgia Athens campus for the conclusion of the program via the Executive Capstone. Over 4 days (Monday–Thursday), students utilize and demonstrate the skills they’ve developed as they compete in a simulated business environment.

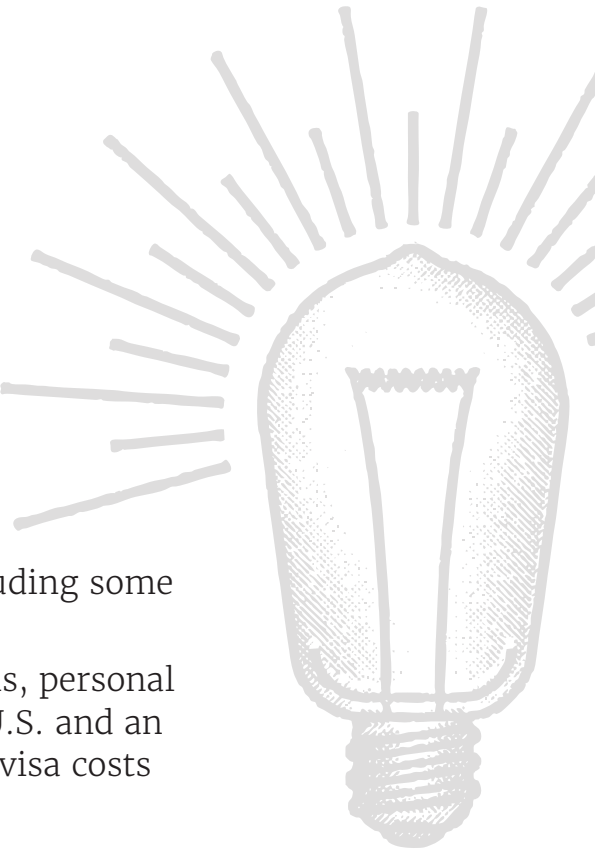
