

TERRY COLLEGE BUSINESS MINOR - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **What are the prerequisite courses to apply to the minor?**
 - Students must **complete** either the Accounting or Economics prerequisite before the semester of application. The other prerequisite must either be completed or be in-progress at UGA in the same semester in which you apply to the minor.
 - Accounting Prerequisite: ACCT 1160 or ACCT 2101
 - Economics Prerequisite: ECON 2105 or ECON 2106
 - You may use earned AP/IB/transfer credit to satisfy the prerequisite course requirements; however, **credit must be posted to your official UGA academic record by the application deadline.**
 - If ECON 2105/2106 credit is being used to satisfy Area V, an accepted student will use ECON in the minor and need to satisfy the Area V requirement with another eligible course.
 - MIST 2090 is not required to complete the minor.
- **How do I determine if I meet the GPA and credit hour eligibility requirements?**
 - Business minor applicants must have successfully completed a minimum of 15 UGA hours, 45 Overall hours, and earned a 3.2 UGA/Institutional GPA
 - The easiest way to find this information is in **Athena on your Student Profile**. Go to [Athena](#) > Student > Student & Registration > Student Profile. On the *Curriculum, Hours, and GPA* section on the upper right side, click on the *Hours & GPA* tab. Keep in mind that PEDB courses will not count towards the hour requirements.
- **How do I view my standardized test scores in Athena?**
 - You can view your standardized test scores (ACT/SAT only) in Athena > Student > Student & Registration > Student Profile. Then, under your photo, click on “Prior education and testing”. The page should then load your test scores.
 - **E-Proficiency Profile (EPP) scores are not reported in Athena** but will be automatically reported to the Terry College by UGA Testing Services. You can email scores@uga.edu if you would like to receive your score.
- **Should I take the E-Proficiency Profile?**
 - If you **have not taken the ACT or SAT**, you must take the [E-Proficiency Profile \(EPP\)](#) to be eligible to apply to the business minor.
 - In addition to required ACT/SAT scores, students may also supplement their application by submitting a score from the EPP if they believe their ACT/SAT scores do not represent their current performance level.
- **Which Accounting course should I take?**
 - Students should take ACCT 1160 *Survey of Accounting* unless the student’s major requires ACCT 2101 or they are unable to register for ACCT 1160.
- **Are there grade requirements for the minor?**
 - All 15 hours of the required coursework must be earned with a **grade of “C” or better**
- **Can I have early access to FINA 3001, MARK 3001, or MGMT 3001?**
 - Due to high demand and limited capacity in these courses, **no early access to FINA 3001, MARK 3001 or MGMT 3001** will be given to students who plan to apply to the minor.
- **What if I’ve already earned credit in FINA 3001, MARK 3001, or MGMT 3001?**
 - If these courses were taken through UGA and you earned a grade of “C” or better, previously earned credit can count toward the business minor.
 - Only students who apply and are accepted to the minor are eligible to have the business minor listed on their university record.
- **Can I use study abroad credit to satisfy minor requirements?**
 - It depends. **Only UGA credit for MARK 3001, MGMT 3001, and FINA 3001 can satisfy the minor’s residency requirement.** Equivalent courses completed through a non-UGA study abroad program will NOT be accepted. For example, credit for MARK 3000 earned through the University of New Orleans study abroad program in Innsbruck, Austria, cannot count toward the minor.
- **When are admissions decisions released?**
 - Our goal is to release decisions before the registration period for the next semester begins. There are several factors that influence this timeline, so we encourage students to remain patient and flexible.
