UGA & Terry Residency Requirements: Candidates for first baccalaureate degrees who matriculate at UGA fall 2003 and thereafter **must earn at least 45 of the last 60 semester credit hours in residence.** In addition, **30 hours of Terry prefix coursework must be completed at UGA** in order to earn a BBA degree.

Terry Major Admissions

- The Terry College is high-demand and has a separate major admissions process. Interested students are admitted to UGA as Intended Business majors.
- Students can only apply to a Terry major after being admitted and enrolled at UGA. **There is no direct admission to a Terry major for your first semester at UGA.**
- Because there is no direct admission to a Terry major, we recommend that you save **some core classes to take during your first semester at UGA.**
- Admitted UGA Students can apply to a first- and second-choice Terry Major once they meet the minimum admissions eligibility requirements (typically around sophomore year). Visit our [Terry Major Admissions webpage>>](#) for complete details.
