## ISMS Financial Support for Dependent Caregivers

## **Expenses Allowed**

- A caregiver's travel expenses to the attendee's home.
- Dependent travel to a caregiver's location outside of the attendee's home community.

## Reimbursement

• Documentation and proof of expenses must be submitted after the conference to INFORMS to receive reimbursement.

## Selection

- Students presenting at the conference on a first-come basis.
- Then junior faculty within six years of receiving their terminal degree presenting at the conference on a first-come basis.
- Then all others on a first-come basis.
- Only one award per household.
