FRESHMAN YEAR

- Maintain a strong GPA
- Focus on the entrance requirements and acceptance to your full major

SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Maintain a strong GPA
- Apply to your full major
- Attend career fairs, secure an internship or co-op, preferably business-related
- Attend an MSBA information session to learn more and review program details

JUNIOR YEAR

- Maintain a strong GPA
- Continue and secure internships/co-ops
- Prepare for GMAT or GRE
- Submit the Double Dawg Interest Form

SENIOR YEAR

- Complete Undergraduate requirements
- Fall - Take 1 (3 cr) graduate-level (6000) MSBA course*
- Spring - Take 1 (3 cr) graduate-level (6000) MSBA course*
- Apply to the MSBA program
Preferably apply on or before November 1, apply.terry.uga.edu
- *Courses must count toward undergraduate program and MSBA

SUMMER BEFORE MSBA

- At least 1 internship must be completed
- Complete online MSBA Boot Camps
- Attend **mandatory** MSBA Orientation (starts August)

MSBA YEAR

- Take 27+ hours of MSBA courses
- Graduate with MSBA in Spring

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

➤ **1-Page Résumé**

➤ **1 Letter of Recommendation**

Preferably from an internship supervisor

➤ **Unofficial Transcripts**

3.0+ preferred

➤ **Unofficial GMAT or GRE Scores**

➤ **Essays**

1 required, 1 optional, 1 video essay optional

➤ **\$75 Application Fee**

➤ **Internship/Co-Op**

MSBA applicants must have at least one internship/co-op before applying
